INSTALLATION OF FACILITIES AND ALTERATION OF RIGHT-OF-WAYS

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING NOTICE TO AND APPROVAL OF THE TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS FOR INSTALLATION OF PRIVATE OR PUBLIC FACILITIES AND OR ALTERATION OF TOWNSHIP ROAD RIGHT-OF-WAYS.

hereby ordains as follows:

No person or entity shall construct a driveway, access road or way bisecting or intersecting in any manner with a Township road, a drainage ditch or ditch, culvert, pipe, conduit, gutter or the like or shall make any alteration of the grade or erect or construct any obstruction to the continued use of the roads, footwalks, culverts, drains and bridges of the Township in or upon the right-of-way of any Township road without first making application for and obtaining approval of the same from the Supervisors of the Township of West Caln or their designees.

The penalty for violation shall consist of the following:

Any person, persons or entity who shall violate this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace be subject to a penalty of fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) nor more than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00), together with costs of prosecution for each such violation or in default of the payment thereof shall suffer imprisonment in the County jail for a period of not more than five (5) days.
