CURFEW ORDINANCE

An Ordinance prohibiting boys and girls under sixteen (16) years of age to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or public places in the Township of West Caln at night after the hour of ten (10) o'clock P.M. during the regular school season and eleven (11) o'clock P.M. during the summer vacation season unless accompanied as hereon provided: during the manner of enforcement and fixing the penalty for violation of this ordinance. Boys and girls between ages sixteen (16) and eighteen (18) are prohibited to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, (18) are prohibited to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, or public places in the Township of West Caln at night after the parks or public places in the Township of West Caln at night after the hour of eleven (11) o'clock P.M. during the regular school season and hour of eleven (11) o'clock P.M. during the regular school season and the summer vacation season unless accompanied as hereon provided; during the summer vacation season unless accompanied as hereon provided; of this ordinance.

The Township of West Caln hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for boys and girls under sixteen (16) years of age (such persons being defined for the purpose of this ordinance section of age (such persons being defined for the purpose of this ordinance section) to be or remain in or upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or public places in the Township of West Caln at night, after the hour of ten (10) o'clock P.M. during the regular school season and eleven (11) o'clock (10) o'clock P.M. during the summer vacation season, unless such child is accompanied by P.M. during the summer vacation season, unless such child is accompanied by any parent, guardian or other person having the legal custody of such child, any parent, guardian or other person having the legal custody of the after which all such children shall be required to be at home or our of the after which all such children shall be required to be at home or our of the streets, alleys, parks, and public places in the Township, except as herein provided for.

Section 1-A. Section 1 shall be applicable to boys and girls between the ages of sixteen (16) to eighteen (18) years of age with the curfew hour being eleven (11) esclock P.M. during the regular school season and during the summer vacation season.

Section 2: It is hereby made unlawful for any parent, guardian or other person having the legal care or custody of any of the children of the age above designated to allow or permit any such child, ward or other person under such age, while in such legal custody, to go or be in or upon any of under such age, while in such legal custody, to go or be in or upon any of the streets, alleys, parks or public places in said Township after the time the streets, alleys, parks or public places in said Township as therein prohibited in Section 1 and Section 1A. of this ordinance, except as therein provided.

Section 4: Said children who shall violate this ordinance more than three times shall be reported to a society or organization whose purpose is to take charge of incorrigibles and delinquents and proceedings be taken in the Court of Quarter Sessions or Juvenile Court for their permanent welfare, and a like procedure shall be taken in cases where the arrest of the parent, guardian or legal custodian shall not be effective or where for any reason the provisions of Section 1. of this ordinance cannot be make effective by fines and penalties imposed thereunder.

Section 5: The police officers of the Township in taking children into custody under this ordinance shall use their discretion in determining age, and in doubtful cases may require positive proof, and until such proof is furnished, the officer's judgment shall prevail.

Section 6: If any sentence clause or section of this ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not effect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses or sections or parts of this ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Supervisors that this ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, section or part thereof not been included herein.
