

TOWNSHIP OF WEST CALN
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA

ORDINANCE NUMBER 29

An Ordinance providing for restricted use of certain public highways and roadways within the Township of West Caln enacted pursuant to the authority granted by the Act of June 17, 1976, P.L. 162 No. 81 Sec. 1 effective July 1, 1977 as amended and necessitated by reason of traffic conditions and other safety factors as well as the deterioration of the said highways and roadways.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Caln, Chester County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

(a) It is unlawful for any person to drive or move, or for the owner to cause or permit to be driven or moved on any of the following highways or roadways within the Township of West Caln, any vehicle or vehicles exceeding five (5) tons gross weight unless the said vehicle or vehicles is or are used for the purpose of making local deliveries to a person or persons who reside upon the said roads:

(b) Signs shall be erected and maintained designating the restriction set forth in (a) above at each end of the aforementioned highways and roadways. The signs shall be maintained and shall conform

with the manual and regulations published by the Department of Transportation of the Commonwealth.

(c) Any person or entity found to be in violation of the terms of this Ordinance shall be penalized in accordance with the law as designated by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania and in the event that a penalty is not so designated shall pay a fine in an amount not to exceed \$300.00 and upon failure to pay such fine as levied by any Court of the Commonwealth shall be confined by imprisonment not to exceed thirty (30) days.

(d) This Ordinance shall supercede all previous ordinances related to the restricted use of township roads and/or public highways.

(e) The holding of any section of this ordinance or part thereof to be unconstitutional, void or ineffective for any cause shall not be deemed to affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section of this ordinance or part thereof.
