## OHULNANCE # 86-2

AN CADINANCE TO RECULATE PARKING IN THE TOWNSHIP OF VEST CALN TOVINSHIP, CHESTER GOURTY, PENNSYLVANIA AND THE INTOSTITON OF PENALTIES FOR THE NON-COMPLIANCE TEXTSEOF.

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Calm, Chester County, Pennsylvania, under and by virtue of and pursuant to the authority granted and vested by the Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved the 1st day of May, 1933, P.L. 103, as amended, 53 P.S. 65724, do hereby ordain and adopt:

Section 1. Short Title-- This Ordinance shall be known as the "Off Street Parking Ordinance".

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any vehicle, motor vehicle, or trailer to be parked on the paved or traveled surface of any road or highway within the Township of West Caln unless to onload said vehicle or trailer. Such loading or unloading is to exist only while the actual event occurs and is prohibited if it obstructs or impedes traffic.

Section 3. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof, by a summary proceeding, before a District Justice be setenced to pay a fine of not more than \$\frac{1}{2} \int \lambda\_1 \int \lambda\_2 \int \lambda\_
