



**A RESOLUTION OF WEST CALN TOWNSHIP,  
CHESTER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO ADOPT A  
MINOR ACT 537 UPDATE REVISION FOR  
DEVELOPMENT OF A SEWER MANAGEMENT  
PROGRAM TO INCLUDE ON-LOT DISPOSAL  
SYSTEMS, COMMUNITY ON-LOT DISPOSAL  
SYSTEMS AND HOLDING TANK SEWER  
FACILITIES WITHIN WEST CALN TOWNSHIP.**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Act of January 24, 1966, P.L. 1535, No. 537, known as the "Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act," as amended, and the Rules and Regulations of the Department of Environmental Protection ("Department") adopted thereunder, and Chapter 71 of Title 25 of the Pennsylvania Code, requires municipalities to adopt an Official Sewage Facilities Plan providing for sewage services adequate to prevent contamination of waters and/or environmental health hazards with sewage wastes, and to revise said plan whenever it is necessary to meet the sewage disposal needs of the municipality; and

**WHEREAS**, West Caln Township, through the Township's consultant Hydraterra Professionals, LLC, has prepared an Update Revision as described in the above caption of this Resolution which provides for the implementation of a sewage management program; and

**WHEREAS**, West Caln Township, with the guidance of the Township's consultant Hydraterra Professionals, LLC, has determined and finds that the Update Revision conforms to applicable zoning, subdivision, other municipal ordinances and plans, and to a comprehensive program of pollution control and water quality management.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Supervisors of West Caln Township, Chester County, Pennsylvania to hereby adopt and submit to the Department of Environmental Protection for its approval as a revision to the "Official Plan" of West Caln Township, the above referenced Update Revision. West Caln Township hereby assures the Department of the


complete and timely implementation of the said plan as required by law pursuant to Section 5 of Pennsylvania Sewage Facilities Act as amended.




